Five years ago a radio station in Sucre called New Life Radio asked Mosoj Chaski for copies of our programs to air on their FM station. We agreed to give them a selection of programs that we have produced for a nominal fee (7 US cents) on the condition that they not copy and sell them to others.

Today we have 19 radio stations in five different regions of the country airing programs that have been produced at Mosoj Chaski. While many people would see this as helping the "competition", at Mosoj Chaski we see it as an extension of our ministry. Most of these small FM stations have a very tight budget and would not be able to pay a fair price for the programs. Juan Velazco, one of our program producers, is very pleased to know that the programs he spent hours writing and recording are being used to bless not only our own listeners, but those who listen to other stations as well.

At Mosoj Chaski we see this as yet another opportunity to spread the Good News far and wide. Please pray that we might be able to consolidate and strengthen this extension of our ministry.
